

Ronald J Kless, age 87, of Beverly Hills, FL passed away on February 10, 2023 at the HCA Florida Ocala Hospital. Ronald was born on March 10, 1935 in New Brunswick, New Jersey to Nicholas and Helen (Pecha) Kless. He served as a radar technician for the USAF from 1955-1958. Ron moved to Miami, FL after his military service; and met Dolores Torres, a National Airlines stewardess, who Ron then married in 1960.
