As a breast cancer survivor, Shirley took full advantage of retired life with her husband, realizing their dreams of driving west to experience the beauty of our National Parks and trekking the full length of Lewis and Clark's Trail annually, often volunteering their time at park campgrounds along the way. Making lifelong friends during their journeys, Shirley collected stories and memories of her travels, sending countless postcards back home to her loved ones. She will be dearly missed.
