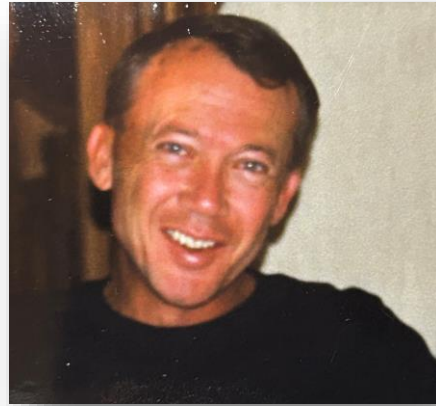


LAWRENCE "LARRY" R. GABLE, Major, United States Marine Corps, Retired, passed away December 2, 2023, under the loving care of his family and VITAS Hospice.
