

Mark Douglas Bryant, 64, of Inverness, Florida, died unexpectedly on March 11, 2024. He was the son of William Spaulding Bryant and Carol Anne Moffett. He was born September 8, 1959 in Lewiston, Maine. He lived in South Paris until he enlisted in the US Air Force in November 1977.

He retired as a Master Sergeant and served in England, Okinawa, Alaska, Germany, Texas, Turkey (with NATO) and in Maryland with the NSA. He was a decorated cryptologist taking part in the rescue of pilot Lt. Col. Dell Zelko after his F-117 was downed over the former country of Yugoslavia.



He is survived by his brother, Stephen & (Patti) Bryant, niece, Cara & (Colin) Stapleton, nephew, Matthew & (Faith Corkum) Bryant, niece, Heather & (Greg Reinhard) Bryant and Amy Bryant. He is also survived by three great nephews; Nathan & James Stapleton and Carter Bryant, along with beloved uncles, aunts, cousins, and step-siblings.

The funeral service will be held at Brown Funeral Home and Crematorium in Lecanto, Florida. Services will be at 2PM for family members and a full military honors service at 3PM, Monday, March 18th, 2024.
