

Larry Eugene Coughenour, age 85 years old, from Homosassa, FL 34446, passed into the arms of Jesus at 8:00 am on December 28, 2024. He was surrounded by his loving family. The cause of death was Pulmonary Fibrosis.

Larry joined the Army on June 5, 1957, and was honorably discharged on March 15, 1960. He was shortly afterwards recruited by the CIA. He and his family moved back to the states in 1988, where he retired from the CIA in 1989. He then worked for Ratheon for an additional 11 years.
